The Fourteenth Green





Situated on the road leading to Bucco Bay, The Fourteenth Green nestles within its own well cared for, secluded, tropical gardens overlooking the golf course.

Tropical fruit trees and birds surround a large single level property composed of the main house and cottage, separated by their own swimming pool.

With its tall ceilings and cool tile floors, the Fourteenth Green is perfectly suited to the Caribbean climate. Its facilities and location make it the ideal venue for a self contained holiday and the perfect base from which to explore the delights and beauty of Tobago.

The Fourteenth Green's constantly maintained swimming pool, adds to the peace and beauty of the property's location. The swimming pool area between the main house and the cottage is equipped with sunloungers, poolside shower, gas barbecue and outdoor dining facilities



The Guest Cottage is independent of the Main House and is situated just the other side of the pool area from the larger property.

The cottage consists of 1 air conditioned double bedroom with en suite and a spacious open plan lounge with fully fitted kitchenette and a breakfast bar.

This main living area opens out onto a covered verandah overlooking the garden and golf course. The verandah is perfect for outdoor dining or for just relaxing within the beauty of the tropical garden.

Like its larger counterpart, the cottage's high ceilings and cool tile floors provide a fresh & roomy atmosphere, ideally suited to the Tobago climate.

The lounge area is fitted with satellite TV.

From its location on the road to Buccoo Bay, the Fourteenth Green is a short eight minute walk to the beach. It is an easy 15 minute drive to Tobago's capital, Scarborough and only a similar distance to the beach at Pigeon Point.

A well stocked general store / grocer is located en route to the property as well as many other stores ideal for other needs, such as photography shops and local souvenir stalls.


Several hotels and restaurants are also within easy reach and cater for all your dining needs. All provide very favourably priced meals, encompassing casual all day eating, more formal evening dining and even early morning breakfast pancakes.

The Mount Irvine Golf Club clubhouse is a 2 - 3 minute drive away and its eighteen hole championship golf course is open at reasonable prices to non-members.

Crown Point Airport is also within an easy 15 - 20 minute drive, which is perfect for ease of arrival and departure; despite the quick journey time there is no aeroplane noise at the property.

The Fourteenth Green's services include a daily maid , 3 telephones, a fax machine, a laundry room with extra deep freeze & fridge, and air conditioning in all bedrooms. The single level layout makes for easy wheelchair accessibility and bathroom 2 is fully equipped with facilities for the disabled.





Tobago is the smallest island of the Republic of Trinidad & Tobago. Approximately 300sq kms with a population of 50,000, and one of the most southerly and unspoilt places in the Caribbean. It's charming and friendly inhabitants contribute to a safe and relaxing atmosphere for the whole family.

The tropical climate sees temperatures fluctuating between 22 C / 71 F at night, to 32 C / 89 F during the day. A usual gentle breeze helps provide a hot yet pleasant climate for most of the year round.

Having been colonised by the Carib Indians, the French, Spanish, Dutch & the British, Tobago is steeped in history and has provided the inspiration for many novelists & artists.

Robinson Crusoe and Swiss Family Robinson both have their roots in this tropical paradise.

The centre of island plays host to a large and mountainous rain forest, rich in rare species of birds and wildlife; while the coast is surrounded by two major coral reefs.

The spectacular Buccoo Reef at the southern tip of the island is easily accessible from the world famous beach at Pigeon Point.





The main house has three double bedrooms, all with air conditioning and french windows, that open out on to the verandah overlooking the gardens and golf course.

The master bedroom has an en suite bathroom, while two additional bathrooms are situated across the hallway from the other bedrooms.

One of these bathrooms, bathroom 2, is also fully fitted with facilities for the disabled.

The spacious kitchen is fully equipped to cater for all your needs, including a dishwasher, as well as all the other amenities required.

The open plan Lounge / Dining Room area is ideal for relaxed or formal meals and includes a TV with satellite channels and video.

The lounge area opens out on to the large covered deck, ideal for alfresco dining or for just relaxing while watching the Humming Birds come and go.

All of which is beautifully maintained by a daily maid service.
